Solution

Coordinate new project teams/subcontractors site safety mentoring programs based on Short Service Employees (SSE) program.

Develop and conduct project specific HSE training and maintain competency HSSEQ training matrix for all crew with assistance from Crewing Department.

Facilitate if/as required onboard (at work site) risk assessments.

Metrics

- Monitor compliance with Company and Client HSE Policy at work sites and sit OCM to achieve an incident injury free operation.
- Monitor Subcontractor compliance through informal and formal auditing and inspections.
- Prepare and communicate daily/weekly/monthly HSSEQ Reports and highlight trends for devising safety improvement plans.
- Participate in HSE/Welfare Committee Meetings and Field Safety/area Inspections and track action items for effective resolution of HSE issues arising.
- Liaise with Client HSE Advisors on project safety improvement initiatives and awareness/training campaigns based on review of incidents, near misses, and ROC card trends and analysis reports.
- Lead incident investigation process and monitor closure of corrective/preventative actions.

Results

Completed work at the direction of client with zero lost time accidents. Under DSS HSE direction, there were also observable improvements in all KPI indicators, with “noted” improvement in vessel ownership of program metrics.
